

Advanced Trauma Life Support Course

Introduction

For over 25 years, the American College of Surgeons Committee on Trauma has taught the Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS®) course in more than 50 countries to over 1 million doctors. ATLS® forms the foundation for the care of the trauma patient by teaching a universal approach and language to trauma care.

The 2-day course combines lectures and hands-on practical skills stations with simulated trauma scenarios to equip trainees with the knowledge and skills for resuscitation, stabilization and management of the acutely injured patient.

The course has been running since 2006 under SingHealth ATLS Centre and the faculty is composed of a select group of doctors from various specialities, each with a wide range of knowledge and experience in teaching. Our Centre trains more than 50 participants on ATLS® each year.

Course Objectives:

The aim of the ATLS® course is to equip the trainees with the knowledge and skills for resuscitation, stabilization and management of the acutely injured patient through a systematic and concise approach to the early care of the trauma patient.

Target Audience:

This course is strongly recommended as a mandatory program for all surgical residents. It is also recommended for House Officers, Medical Officers and any interested clinicians who seek to equip themselves with ATLS® skills.

Learning Outcomes:

At the end of the course, trainees will be able to demonstrate a systematic and concise approach to the early care of the trauma patient.

Validation/Accreditation:

Upon successful completion, candidate will be ATLS® certified as set forth by the American College of Surgeons. Successful completion status is valid for 4 years from the course date. Singapore Registered doctors will also receive accreditation from Singapore Medical Council for Continuing Medical Education. (8 CME Points)

How to Register?
